This handbook comes up with useful information as well as instructions for you to adapt to and get on well with a new learning environment, which can be considered as Your Guide to Information for TDTU's life.





> Currently, we have two separate dormitory buildings, one for males and one for females. Generally, 8 students share one room with a bathroom.

> No cooking is allowed in the dormitory.

> Those who live on the university campus are strongly encouraged to be back in their dorms by 22:00. Students can leave the campus for the entire weekends, during holidays and semester breaks with prior permission of the Residence Dean.





Opening and Closing: 5:00 - 22:00

ne student identity (ID) cards with the information of the student's name, date of birth, student number, class, faculty, major, and training course are issued to registered students at the commencement of their studies and expires at the end of the programs. Students must carry

their ID cards when

on campus as they are used to access several services and are required for identification by the security guards upon entry.

Student ID cards are also integrated with their bank accounts and can be used to get discounts on such services as bus fare, cinema tickets, etc.

The student ID card is the property of the University and must be returned to the office of Student Affairs upon termination of studies for any

reasons. In the event of losing the card, immediately report Department of Student Affairs (A0003) for the new card which costs 50,000VND. In the meantime, students will be issued with a temporary one.



STUDENT HOUSING

MAINTAINING A PEACEFUL CAMPUS







- Wear revealing clothes to temples and public places.






